Built with timber framing and cladding, steel roofing and warm UPVC joinery, ecopods are fully insulated and built to code. Installed by truck and crane where needed, onto pile foundations ready for CCC.

Our Process

There are three main project approaches:

1. No Consent (lead time is about 2 months)

If it's transportable on wheels, or less than 30m² with no plumbing, it may be exempt from Consent. Talk with our team for more info.

2. Consented Building (lead time is about 3 months)

Auckland Council certifies the building 'envelope' to the specified standard. The site consent is handled separately or postponed.

3. Consented Site (lead time is about 6-10 months)

The full monty, involving site plans, pile engineering, decks and steps. May also require Resource Consent. We take care of all of this.

The 8 Steps to Owning Your EcoPod:

1. Discovery

Reach out to us to discuss your dream Ecopod home.

2. Feasibility

Including a site assessment for planning and infrastructure demands of your project.

3. Estimate

Approve your concept plan, with detailed specifications, a project estimate and timeline.

4. Contract

An initial contract allows us to confirm site related costs, then we do a full project contract.

5. Council Consents

Documentation and processing for relevant local authorities.

6. Production

Off-site manufacturing begins, once consents are approved, while any site works take place.

7. Delivery

Our team ensures a smooth delivery of your new Ecopod.

8. CCC & HUG

We issue your Council Code of Compliance Certificate & Ecopod Home User Guide! Enjoy your new Ecopod.




Going Off-Grid

Going off-grid requires attention to your energy, potable water and wastewater systems.


In conjunction with certified electricians, solar and wastewater professionals, we can design a system to meet your unique requirements.

The first step is to calculate upfront what your system requirements are. Getting the right system will save cost, hassle and headaches. We start with a load profile.

There are several ways to help manage an off-grid system, such as use of backup generators, composting toilets with greywater treatment only, fireplaces and thermal hot water tubes. Each situation requires a customised approach.

FAQ's

Do I need Council consent?

Your Preliminary Site Assessment will confirm what form of consent is needed, if any, for your project. If your building is less than 30m2, and has no internal plumbing, it should be exempt. Any other building fixed to the land requires Building Consent. The landowner has ultimate legal responsibility to ensure compliance. With prefab building it's possible to get a Building Consent ex-factory, with onsite consents arranged separately.

Do you offer finance?

We've teamed up with two key partners to offer finance options to our customers. Below, we break down exactly how we can help you finance your Ecopod project starting today. Either, work through brokers at TMF Finance for tiny home finance without owning the land, or go via the dedicated team at Westpac for transportable building financing.

Can I customise my Ecopod?

One of our key strengths at Ecopod is our ability to offer design customisation. From floor layout through to material finishes and colour choices, we strive to satisfy the unique needs of you and your family. Built to the highest design standards, our customised homes still offer warmth, comfort, and durability.

How can I have security on payments?

Through IPromise, funds can be secured in a trust account until certain, agreed milestones are reached. Potentially, IPromise is also a straightforward way for banks to structure their lending, which could useful in supporting a bank application for finance. While the IPromise service is free of charge, Ecopod charges 1% fee on the project price due to our cost to finance your build.

Can you estimate the total project cost?

Absolutely, we are able to provide estimates rapidly once we've completed our Preliminary Site Assessment. All we need to do that is your site address, desired placement location and size of your Ecopod. If you're happy with the estimate, we can provide more accurate pricing in our next stage, upon receiving your initial feasibility deposit.
